Parents and Guardians,

The state of Alabama requires that all students take the Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program (ACAP) Summative Exams. Therefore, we are asking all students to report to school to test. The dates are on the back of this letter.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What time should students arrive?
 - a. Students should arrive by 7:30. Take in is at 7:05 and Breakfast is from 7:10-7:30.
2. How will students get to and from school?
 - a. Students can ride the school bus or be dropped off. Testing should end by Noon each day. Students can be picked up at that time or they can ride the bus home.
3. Do students have to wear uniforms?
 - a. MCPSS does not require virtual students to be in uniform. We will have themes for each day and students will be allowed to dress for each theme.
4. What tests will my child take?
 - a. All students take Reading & Math. There are 3 Reading Sections and 2 Math sections. There are 2 Science sections which are given to **6th and 8th grade only**.
5. Does my child need a computer to test?
 - a. Students will test on MCPSS Samsung Chromebooks, MCPSS Lenovo Laptops, MCPSS HP laptops, MCPSS iPads, or desktops at school. They cannot test on personal devices.
6. What is the digital device policy?
 - a. Cell Phones, smartwatches, headphones, and other electronic devices are not allowed in the testing sessions and will be collected by administration each morning and given back at the end of testing each day. We suggest leaving them at home.
7. What precautions is the school taking?
 - a. All students and staff will wear masks. Students will test on the same devices and sit in the same desks each time they test. The testing areas will be sanitized after each use. We have hand sanitizer and disinfectant in each classroom and common areas are sprayed throughout the day.
8. Make Up Sessions
 - a. If you would prefer a smaller session or miss a day, you can test during a makeup day. Makeup days are listed on the back. Just call the school and let us know the makeup day you are bringing your child to test.

We need your support. Please ensure that your child gets a good night's rest each day of testing. Teachers and students have been working hard to prepare for the test.
