

**Minutes**  
**Andalusia City Board of Education**  
**March 26, 2012**  
**5:30 p.m.**

Present: Dr. Bill King, Jr., Dr. David McCalman, Amy Dugger, David Bryant, Joe Nix, and Ted Watson, Superintendent.

Dr. Bill King, Jr. called the meeting to order. Pierre Johnson, an Andalusia High School student, led the pledge. Superintendent Ted Watson presented Pierre with a certificate of appreciation.

**Approval of Board Minutes** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of the February 21, 2012 board minutes. Upon a motion by David Bryant, seconded by Amy Dugger, these were approved.

**Financial Report** Jean Sellers, Chief Schools Financial Officer, presented the financial report for the period ending February 21, 2012. No action was taken.

**2012-2013 Scholastic Calendar** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of the 2012-2013 Scholastic School Calendar. Upon a motion by Joe Nix, seconded by Dr. David McCalman, this was approved.

**AHS Soccer Coach Supplement** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of Tim Ramsden as Head Soccer Coach and Candy Parker as Assistant Soccer Coach with a supplement of \$750 each. Upon a motion by David Bryant, seconded by Amy Dugger, this was approved.

**Textbook Adoption** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of the entire list of state adopted textbooks for Mathematics with the regulations set forth by the State Textbook Laws. Upon a motion by Dr. David McCalman, seconded by Joe Nix, this was approved.

**AMS Closing** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of closing the Andalusia Middle School and placing the sixth grade at the Andalusia Elementary campus and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade at the Andalusia High School campus. Upon a motion by David Bryant seconded by Amy Dugger, the vote was 4 to 1 with Joe Nix voting No. The motion was approved.

**Comments** Superintendent Ted Watson introduced the proposed changes to current board policies, (6.70) Drug & Alcohol-Free Work Place, (5.12 School Admission) Admission of Homeless, Migratory, Immigrant and Limited English Proficient Students. No action was taken.
