<u>LHHS ATHLETICS SCHOOL GUIDELINES 2020-2021 WINTER SPORTS -</u> LAKE HAVASU HIGH SCHOOL

Admission:

At this time there will be no visiting spectators. Only 2 designated parents/guardians will be admitted from LHHS. Those parents/guardians will be identified at the start of the season and must stay the same for the entire season.

\$5.00 general admission, \$3.00 students (k-12), seniors (65+), and Military. AIA Passes are accepted (must still be a parent/guardian of an athlete). Exact change is preferred and appreciated.

Concessions:

Limited concessions may be available if possible. Coolers will not be allowed in the gym or in the football stadium. Food will not be allowed in the gym. Individual water will be allowed.

PPE:

Masks must be worn by spectators, coaches and players at all times when inside and on the Lake Havasu High School Campus. Masks must be on when in the gym and inside the football/Soccer stadium. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer and wash their hands regularly.

Fan Limitation:

Only 2 designated parents/guardians will be admitted. Those parents/guardians will be identified at the start of the season and must stay the same for the entire season. No visiting spectators are permitted at this time.

<u>Facemasks are required to be worn at all times by everyone at the event</u>. Admission will still need to be paid upon arrival.

Seating:

Home team guests should socially distance as a family unit. Please seat away from others. Available seating on the bleachers is identified by an "X." You must sit at an identified "X." Additionally, please do not sit immediately behind the team bench and score table. Thank you.

Live Stream:

A live stream of the home match/game will be provided most of the time, when available. The live stream link will be shared with the opposing team the day of the match. The link will also be posted on the HAVASU ONLINE TV LIVE Facebook page prior to the start of the match.

Spectators:

Only 2 designated parents/guardians will be admitted. Those parents/guardians will be identified at the start of the season and must stay the same for the entire season. No visiting spectators are permitted at this time.

We ask all home team spectators to socially distance as a family unit. Once your athlete is done competing, we ask that you do not stay and socialize. No Away Team Spectators Will be Allowed at This Time. Please follow all posted signage and use common sense. Stay home if you show symptoms or if you have been in close contact with a positive case of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.

Visiting Schools:

At this time, <u>No Away Team Spectators Will be Allowed</u>. Only those traveling with the team and are deemed necessary will be allowed.

Sideline Personnel:

Persons on the sidelines (sideline personnel) will be restricted to players, coaches, athletic trainers, athletic directors, school administration, and game administration personnel. Sideline personnel must wear face masks. Officials have the authority to notify game administration about unauthorized personnel and have them removed from the sideline.

Expectations:

Spectators are expected to follow LHUSD and Athletic Dept. guidelines. Failure to follow LHUSD and Athletic Dept. guidelines will result in removal from the event with no refund. No Re-entry.
