Important Information for Transitioning to Online Courses

#### Important Reminders

- Grades for the 4<sup>th</sup> Term for all underclassmen (and Seniors taking Government) will count and work must be completed to earn credits.
- All courses will utilize the Edgenuity platform except for ACCESS courses already in progress, Drivers Education, and Advanced Placement courses. There could be a few other exceptions on a case by case basis. In that case, the instructor for that course will contact students to notify.
- Check your student email daily!

#### **Email Login Information**


- Login through the "Office 365" link on the home page of the school website: https://holtvillehighelmoreal.schoolinsites.com/
- Username format is the student's first initial and last name plus a unique 4-digit number
   @student.elmoreco.com
- The password is the last 7 digits of the student state i.d. number.
- If a student does not know this information, he/she must contact his/her Advisory teacher through email. (Hint: If you need to email your teacher and cannot access your school email account, you may want to set up a free Gmail account at Google.com)
- All faculty/staff emails are in the format <u>first.lastname@elmoreco.com</u> or can be accessed through the school website

#### Steps for Student Login

#### Please use the following steps to access Edgenuity:

- 1. Go to the following website: www.edgenuity.com
- 2. Click on the yellow login button at the top of the page.
- 3. Click on the blue student login button on the left side of the middle of the page.
- Once on the student login page, you will need to enter your username and password using your Elmore County credentials.
- \* Please note: The username is the student's email address and the password is the same password you use for all of your Elmore County school accounts. If you need assistance retrieving your password, please contact your teacher or school technology coordinator.
- 5. Once you login to Edgenuity, you will see a screen that looks like the following:



 Before beginning, you must watch the Student Orientation video to provide an overview and introduce you to Edgenuity.



#### Online Course Tips

- Commit to a schedule/routine. \*\*You may want to just follow your normal class schedule.
- When you are scheduled to work, work hard.
- Put away all distractions while working. Examples Turn off t.v., Put phone in a separate room with sound off, etc.
- Schedule short breaks to ensure that you don't "burn out" before you finish everything you need to for the current day.
- Carefully watch, listen, or read instructional components of the lessons. You only have the opportunity to take a test or quiz twice. After two unsuccessful attempts, you will have to repeat all the instruction and activities again.




#### **Tutoring Opportunities**

#### PROCEDURES

The Elmore County Child Nutrition Program is working to improve the efficiency and safety of its curbside meal pick-up at the 5 district sites. Starting Monday, April 6th, parents/guardians will be issued a meal tag. If you have volunteered to pick-up meals and deliver to other families, let the worker issuing tags know and they will assist you. All participants must remain in their cars at all times. The meal tag will be issued to you at your car. The meal tag will note how many children ages 18 and under live in the parent/guardian's household. At all future pick-up dates, the meal tag should be placed on the driver's side dashboard and visible for volunteers to see as you drive through the pick-up line. If you are not able to participate on April 6th, meal tags will also be available for issue on all future serving dates.



Elmore County Child Nutrition program offers free take-home meals for all children ages 18 and under. On each pick-up day, children will receive 7 breakfast meals and 7 lunch meals. Meals will be distributed from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Mondays (4/6, 4/13, 4/20, 4/27, 5/4, 5/11, 5/18) at the following sites:


