Spelling Words

This week we are working on CVC patterns (just like in phonics). Here are a few examples: **tub**, **lip**, **pot**, **hat**

Sight Words a, and, of, the, is, his

Sight words are words that we see frequently in our text. Students should know them quickly, without having to sound them out.

Students will not be tested on sight words, but should be able to read and write them correctly
