Remote Asynchronous Instruction

- Based upon the guidance from the State, the remote instruction option will require a higher level of rigor, workload and time commitment from the virtual learning model that occurred in the spring of 2020.
- Remote instruction will require support from caring adults at home and within the online classroom environment.
- Remote instruction will follow the schedule of classes at the student's home campus (secondary) or daily time expectations per content area (elementary).
- The Remote instruction schedule will require students to participate in asynchronous (online without real-time interaction) and synchronous (real-time) online learning.
- Each day, students will engage in daily lessons, activities and assignments in all classes in order to be marked present for the day.
- Grading for all remote courses will follow the same grading policy as the courses in the on-campus model.
- Due to the rigor and participation expectations of remote instruction, each student will need to pick up a school chromebook and have access to high-speed internet at home, or may ask for a school hotspot.
- Students who participate in remote instruction may have access to "grab and go" meals.
