

212.1L SCHOOL BOARD RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP; WEST CENTRAL HONORS PROGRAM

- A. The West Central Honors Program/NYM School Board Recognition Scholarship is a cooperative project in which business, industry, communities and school give recognition and scholarships to deserving students representing the forty-one school districts in the Lakes Country Service Cooperative Unit.
- B. Each school district in the LCSCU will nominate a pre-determined number of students in twelfth grade to be recognized. Selections will be based on:
 - (1) Academic achievement
 - (2) Leadership skills
 - (3) Participation in school and community activities
- C. These students will be invited to attend an honors banquet and will be eligible for regional scholarships. In addition, up to four scholarships not to exceed the amount the service cooperative awards will be awarded to four students from the New York Mills School district. Selection criteria and recipients will be left to the discretion of the committee.
- D. The local selection committee shall consist of:
 - (1) Three Board of Education Members
 - (2) High School Principal
 - (3) Two instructors
 - (4) High School counselor
- E. In, addition, several regional scholarships will be awarded. Businesses, schools, industries, trusts, service organizations and private individuals will contribute funds.
