

**Open Campus**

Open Campus is a privilege available to high school all students in good standing. Open Campus is an incentive-based program aimed to encourage increased student achievement while offering a learning environment that provides student freedom with respect and responsibility. Students with Open Campus privileges may leave campus during the lunch period. Students must follow the Open Campus Procedures (Policy No. 529). Parents will assume the responsibility of their child during their time off-campus. Students are expected to be present and on time for class and all academic obligations. Students are to conduct themselves as good citizens and comply with the student code of conduct when off-campus. Open Campus privileges are good for one (1) semester and must be renewed each semester.

To be eligible for Open Campus privileges, a student must meet the following requirements:

1. No more than three disciplinary offenses or trancies in the previous semester.
2. Parent/guardian permission for open campus privileges; and
3. No more than 7 unexcused absences in the current semester.

A student may have Open Campus privileges revoked by school administration for disciplinary, attendance, or academic infractions, which may include, but are not limited to:

1. Late to class more than 6 times;
2. Drug/Alcohol/Tobacco use off-campus while exercising Open Campus privileges;
3. Any violations of student code of conduct while off-campus exercising Open Campus privileges;
4. Detention/Suspension/Expulsion.

The revocation of Open Campus privileges is subject to appeal or reconsideration.

To be considered for Open Campus privileges, a student must follow the procedures in Policy No. 529F1.
