Objectives:

6th Grade Math - Polk

The Number System: 6.NS.1 - Interpret and compute quotients of fractions and solve word problems involving division of fraction by fractions. 6.NS.2 - Fluently divide multi-digit numbers using the standard algorithm. 6.NS.3 - Fluently add, subtract, multiply, and divide multi-digit decimals using the standard algorithm for each operation. 6.NS.4 - Find the greatest common factor and the least common multiple of two whole numbers. 6.NS.5 - Positive and negative numbers. 6.NS.6 - Understand a rational number as a point on the number line.
