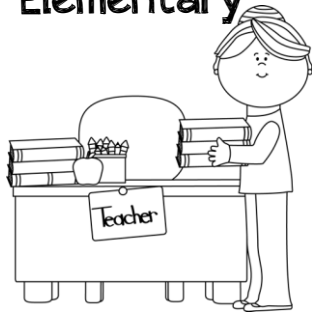

Supply List

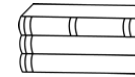


*These items are used every day and may need replaced each nine weeks:
*crayons (24 pack)
*glue sticks (8)
*#2 lead pencils (24 count)
*erasers (4) – rectangle ones work great!
*tissues (2 boxes)
backpack
scissors (1)
liquid glue bottle (1)
pencil box or bag to hold all supplies (1)
disinfectant wipes (1)
art shirt
headphones or earbuds in a plastic bag with student name
