March 27, 2014

-REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING-

The Board President Andy Bowman called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., in the East Carter Co. R-II Elementary Cafeteria. The following board members were present: Ben Thies, George Meyers, Andy Bowman, Rick Saffle and Mark Hampton. Board member John Walker was absent. Also present were the following: Superintendent Richard Sullivan, Elementary Principal Angie Bowman, Middle School Principal Theresa Kearbey, High School Principal Robert Eudaley, Special Services Director Danielle Sullivan, Treasurer Jamie Shaffer and Secretary Linda Sandage; also present were Tina Wilkins, Janet Hampton, Becky Tindall, Dawn Hood, Tami Atchison and Matt Thornton. Tanya Turner of OPPA Food Services and Susie Fann of East Carter Custodial Services. The agenda was adopted by the board.

-SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT-

Superintendent Richard Sullivan reported the electric bill was up \$1192.45 from last year. Some of the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be attending a math bowl at Ellington tomorrow. Mr. Sullivan reported that we have missed 24 days of school this year due to inclement weather. Also he reported that there is a legislative petition being circulated around the state purported to be 'for teachers', perhaps with references to merit pay. This is actually a signature drive for an item potentially to be added to the November election for a majority of a teacher's evaluation being based from student testing results. Mr. Sullivan ended his report by going over the bills.

-MINUTES/BILLS-

The minutes of the January 27, 2014, regular board meeting and the bills were approved.

-NEW BUSINESS-

The school district will donate \$1000.00 to Project Graduation. High School Principal Robert Eudaley presented to the Board rules and guidelines for the Prom. Principal Angela Bowman reported to the Board that some of the elementary students had competed in the Lesterville Academic Bowl. They did very well. Middle School Principal reported congratulations to the middle school students that attended the spelling bee at Doniphan on March 19<sup>th</sup>. The following students placed: Autumn Payne 5<sup>th</sup> grade placed 2<sup>nd</sup>, Avenleign Ladnier 6<sup>th</sup> grade placed 2<sup>nd</sup> and Mya Henderson 8<sup>th</sup> grade placed 2<sup>nd</sup>. Also Mrs. Kearbey wanted to say congratulation to the winners in the Am Vets American Essay Contest: The East Carter County Middle School all three placed in the contest for the 7/8<sup>th</sup> grade categories. 8<sup>th</sup> grade was 1<sup>st</sup> place Kaley Thies, 2<sup>nd</sup> place Linda Tucker and 3<sup>rd</sup> was Maya Henderson. 7<sup>th</sup> grade 1<sup>st</sup> place was Brenda Staples, 2<sup>nd</sup> place was Keith Eudaley and 3<sup>rd</sup> place was Liberty Scott.

Laura Eudaley reported that on March 14, 2014, the students that placed at the local National History Day contest competed at the Region 9 Contest in Cape Girardeau. The Junior Group

Performances both placed. They qualify to compete at the State Contest April 26, 2014. The Board approved the State History Contest trip proposal as presented. The Student Tutoring Program Report was approved by the Board. Summer school dates were approved for May 29, 2014 to June 24, 2014. Also the Board approved Summer School to work in cooperation with the Carter County Public Library, which will allow Summer School to use the resources the Library has available to them. OPAA Food Service for was approved for the Summer School Program. It was approved to extend East Carter Custodial contract until December 2014. The estimated non-binding tax rate for fund 1 as 2.7500, fund 2, fund 3 and fund 4 as 0.0000 was approved by the Board. The Board approved to maintain membership in the Black River League. The Board voted to absorb one of the Classroom Reduction positions for the 2014-15 District Budget. The 2014-15 Certified, Non Certified Salary Schedule with step was adopted. The Board approved the following: to open another music position for the 2014-15 school year, to rescind MSBA policy JECB and to adopt MSBA policies BDA,BDC, BDDF, DB, DFA, EBC VERSION 2, EBCA, ECA, FEB, GBBDA, GBCC, GBLB, IGAC, IHB, IL, JEA, JEC, JECA, JECB, JGF and JHCD and JOAP, and the Head Lice Procedures as presented to supersede previous procedures, revised the 2013-14 School Calendar to attend school April 21, 2014 for a weather make up day, transfer \$2,690.00 from Fund 1 to Fund 4 and set the date to reorganize the Board for April 10, 2014, at 6:00 p.m. in the Elementary Cafeteria, of Laura Eudaley as Head Cheerleading Coach for seventh and eighth grade.

Resignations of Nicole Tipton, Special Education Teacher and Laura Eudaley as Head Cheerleading Coach for seventh and eighth grade were accepted. The Board also adopted FY 2015 District Calendar Proposal A.

Middle School Principal Theresa Kearbey thanked Larry White for making the bus inspection with the Highway Patrol a success. She reported that he has worked hard this year to make sure that we not only pass inspection, but that we passed with 100%.
