

Plan For Reinspection / Periodic Surveillance

In accordance with Sections 763.85 (b) and 763.92 (b) of the Act, the LEA or its designated person shall conduct:

1) Reinspection by an Accredited Inspector - At least once each three years the management plan is in effect (which is until all ACBM is removed from the building), according to Federal regulations. Connecticut regulations require reinspection by an accredited inspector at least once a year.

2) Periodic Surveillance - At least once every six months after the management plan is in effect. This surveillance shall include:

a) A visual inspection of all areas that are identified in the management plan which contain ACBM or assumed ACBM.

b) Records of the date of the surveillance, the name of person conducting the inspection, and any changes in the condition of the materials.

c) Submittal to the person designated to carry out general local education agency responsibilities, a copy of such record for inclusion in the management plan.
