

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DIRECTIONS

In order to use these QR codes, you will need:

- 1. A device to scan the code, such as an old smartphone, iPod, iPad, or other tablet
- 2. A QR Code Scanning app. A free app that I use is QR Code Reader & Barcode Scanner. However, there are several free options to choose from in the App Store!

3. Wi/Fi

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Then you're all set! Simply copy the page you need, put it next to your device, and let the students get to work! Your kids will need crayons and pencils to work through the activity.

The best part? Students will listen and follow directions by coloring each picture according to what I say. We will focus on listening and following directions, as well as review lots of different language arts and math skills. I am a 23 year veteran teacher and it's like I'll be taking a small group in your class!

My class loves these activities every year! I hope your class will, too!


Skills

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Students will write words to match pictures, read fluently with expression, edit a sentence, write a sentence, draw spots on a ladybug to count backwards from any number, etc.

MP3 Files



PowerPoint Slides with Audio










Answer Keys

The following pages are the answer keys. However, please keep in mind that the colors can vary. In order to make this activity fun and engaging, and NOT stressful, I emphasized that the colors could be *some kind* of blue, or *some kind* of red, or *some kind* of green.


As a full time first grade teacher, I know that red, black, brown, and yellow crayons tend to disappear. So, in my classroom, it's okay to use a red-violet crayon if you can't find your red crayon. The same goes with several other colors. Besides lessening the stress on the student, it lessens my stress, as well! Ha!


Also, if students don't have a gray crayon, I encourage them to use their black crayon (lightly) or use their pencil to make a shade of gray.


So even though this is an "answer key", please don't take the coloring portion too seriously.


However, the bottom portion should be correct because we complete it together.
