

Call Out for April 9, 2021

This is Richard Dennis, Superintendent of Elmore County Public Schools.

This week 3 employees and 9 students reported testing positive for COVID-19 which reflects the green health status over most of the state. Governor Ivey's mask order will expire today, so beginning April 12, masks will be optional for employees and students. We will continue to adhere to the other required ADPH and ALSDE guidelines.

Our Spring ACAP testing window is well underway for required schools, and reminders have been sent to both traditional and virtual students on specific dates and times that your student should be present. High schools are currently making up ACT, Pre-ACT, and ACT WorkKeys, while elementary and middle school students are involved in the ACAP Summative and Alternate testing programs.

Please, be reminded that April 16 is the deadline to register your student for EDGE, Elmore County's virtual school. The EDGE will be the only virtual option for Elmore County Public School students next year. Visit the Elmore County website for information.
