**Facility Project Update**

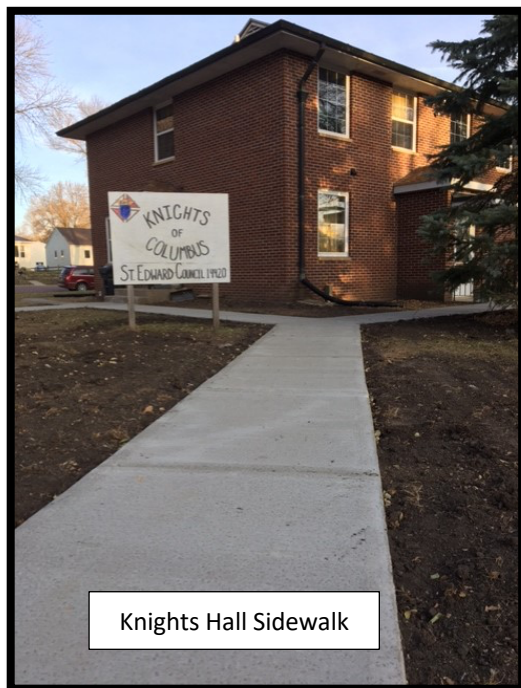
**Repair and Improvement Projects Completed/Planned – November 2020**

- The parking lot was resurfaced over the summer.
- Some of the sidewalks around Knights Hall were replaced. The remainder will be replaced in 2021.
- The 4 entrance roofs to Knights Hall were replaced with gabled roofs.
- The roof on the rectory was replaced.
- The windows for the rectory have been ordered and will be installed as time and weather permits.
- The roof area of the school that leaks will be repaired, and downspouts will be added to prevent further leaking in 2020.
- The leak at the east entryway of the church will be repaired in 2020, with the full roof repair in 2021.
- The church steeple will be repaired in 2021.
- A bid for the church steps has been requested. The steps will be repaired in 2021.
