- 6) Covid protocols and procedures update
  - i) We function as closed cohorts. We also have cohorts in a cohort.
  - ii) We have had some individuals quarantined and will be following the newest guidelines sent out this week from the CDC.
- 7) School Improvement Update
  - i) Following our school improvement focus on improving reading this fall, we have gathered data from all assessments and moved forward with targeted instruction.
  - ii) At the beginning of December, all students/parents received a current reading level. This included “next steps” with visuals for students to follow. Strategies were based on the “Matching Books to Readers” document provided by Teachers College Reading and Writing Project (NY). These levels match our “LJPS Essential Standards Sheets”, which were sent home at the beginning of the year.
  - iii) We are also continuing to monitor reading levels monthly. In our professional learning committees, we discuss the strategies needed to move students to their next levels.
  - iv) An additional 45 students will return to in person instruction from Houston Virtual. We will have two teachers continuing to teach Houston Virtual for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. (We started with six Houston Virtual teachers in August.)
- 8) Spirit Day Initiatives---we continue to have spirit day Zooms to in-person and Houston Virtual to raise school spirit and morale.
- 9) Santa Drop-We will be following our spirit day Zoom model and will be having a pre-recorded Santa visit for students to watch and the letters will be delivered by the office. This will allow for everyone to remain in their classrooms and socially distanced.
- 10) Future assessments--- iReady was given to distance learners again for a December benchmark. In January, MAP will be administered to students in-person and virtual. This data will be triangulated with classroom data to formulate “next steps” for students for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
