

An Overview of School Messenger Notifications

Good morning,

There seems to be a little confusion over the School Messenger notifications that are being sent on the mornings of inclement weather. It is my hope that this explanation will help.

On a morning of inclement weather, two notifications are sent by the superintendent.

First Notification:

Who Receives It:	Anyone who has enrolled in email or text notifications
When:	As early as possible
What types of notification:	Email and text notification
What will these notifications say?:	This notification will explain that there is either a two-hour delay or school has been cancelled.

Second Notification:

Who Receives It:	Anyone who has enrolled in phone notifications (You will not receive the text or email notifications unless you have given consent to receive them under the "My Account" section of School Messenger.)
When:	6:00am
What types of notification:	Phone call, email, and text notification
What will these notifications say?:	The phone call will be a recording, explaining the need for the call. The email and text notification will state that you have a voice message waiting. It will include a link to a webpage to allow you to hear the recording.
