#### **NEW SMART SNACK POLICY**

Due to new regulations on school wellness policies put in place by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), effective July  $1^{\rm st}$ , Dorchester School District 4 will have to regulate treats brought into the school (birthday treats, celebratory treats, etc.) starting this school year. Treats must follow the new "Smart School Snack" guidelines.

## **Tiger Town Homework Center**

The primary program goals of the TTHC are to provide academic assistance and recreation for students after school. The 2019-2020 fee for the Homework Center is \$50 per child. Four (4) day weeks will be \$40.00. Adjustments may be needed in case of inclement weather. The TTHC operates in accordance with DD4 policies regarding early school closing in the event of emergency weather conditions.

A parent/guardian must come in to register student(s). Payment will be due at that time. No checks, only cash, will be accepted. Please do NOT send money or registration forms with students. Registration forms are available in the Front Office when you come in. Payment is due up front either on the Friday before or Monday of the current week for the entire week. Services will be suspended if no prepayment is made for a week. There will be NO pay per day option.

All students will participate in Academic Time from 3:00-4:00 P.M. Two teachers will work with students on homework or tutoring during this time. Students who do not have homework or need tutoring will need a book to read during this time.

Pick-up is in the Cafeteria. Please drive to the back of the building and use the loop between the new wing and the cafeteria. Parents or guardians must sign out children daily.

The TTCH will NOT be open on Early Release Days, the week of Thanksgiving, or the week we get out for Christmas.

A light snack/meal will be provided.
