Eligibility

This scholarship is available only to graduating seniors in the year of their graduation. It is for one year only and it is not renewable.

Each applicant must complete the entire application. Any application that does not have all of the below listed requirements and correct spelling will not be considered.

1. Complete the application.
2. List their educational goals for the future.
3. List their high school and community accomplishments.
4. Two letters of recommendation- one from a school official and one from an adult not affiliated with their school or family.
5. Their high school transcripts signed by the principal.

Applications must be postmarked to the address below no later than May 1 to be eligible.

Awards will be sent to the institutions to be used for tuition, books and/or lab fees.
