Dear Autauga County Parents:

In regards to COVID-19 and the rapidly evolving factors surrounding this pandemic, it is our goal to provide a traditional learning experience for our students and staff in the safest environment possible. In order to ensure that our schools will continue to function within a safe and healthy environment, a joint effort with parents and staff will be critical.

One of the many ways to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 is to monitor your child's symptoms prior to leaving home, on the bus to and from school, and while at school:

- Make a visual inspection of the child for signs of illness such as, rapid breathing, persistent coughing, flushed cheeks, fatigue, and extreme irritability.
- Listen to the child for verbal complaints of body aches, headaches, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell.
- Children with 100.4 temperature should not report to school. Please consult with your health care provider.

Together, we will strive to identify our children who are not well and keep them home for their own protection as well as the protection of their fellow classmates, teachers, and bus drivers. Through early intervention and isolation, healthy hygiene, adequate disinfecting, and proper personal protective equipment, we can stop the rapid spread of COVID-19 within our schools.
