We will continue to work on these standards:

**4.NF.3a Understand that a fraction is  $< 1$ . Add and subtract fractions with mixed numbers and word problems.**

**4.MD.5a Display and interpret data in graphs and solve problems.**

**4.NF.4 Multiply fractions by a whole number.**

Our week will begin with a review of mixed numbers and graphing. We will then introduce multiplying a fraction times a whole number such as  $\frac{2}{3} \times 5$ . Our multiplication skills continue to be very important for so many parts of our curriculum.

### Social Studies - Chapter 10 Ohio as America - Ohio Statehood and the Ohio Constitution
