

**POLICY TITLE: Credit by  
Examination**

A student may receive credit toward high school graduation by passing an examination which assesses the student's knowledge of a given subject. The examinations must be approved and administered by the school district, and cover the content included in a regular secondary education course on the subject. The student passing such examination will not be required to attend the regular school course in which the subject is taught.

A student may receive credit by examination for no more than one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the total credits required for graduation and for no more than one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the core credits required for graduation by this district.
