A community service program will take place at Arthur I. Boreman Elementary for students in grades Preschool through Fifth Grade. We will recognize students who have contributed their time and efforts to improve their communities. A. I. Boreman School encourages all students who wish to apply for community service recognition to read and follow these guidelines. - Community service activities should be at least 15 minutes in length or longer.
- If payment is received, the community service activity will not be counted.
- Examples of approved activities include:
  1. Assisting with any activity that benefits members of the community through some nonprofit organization.
  2. Assisting those individuals in the community who cannot perform necessary activities themselves.
- Participants must maintain an accurate record of community service hours. It is highly recommended that students use the form on the back, and a sponsoring adult must sign each activity. **No credit will be received without a sponsor's signature.**
  - **Return all community service information by May 1, 2017.**
