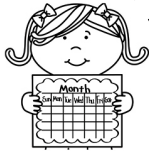

A Note From Mrs. N & Mrs. R



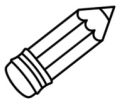

Reading

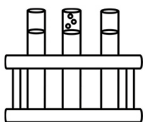
Writing
