

EAST SIDE ELEMENTARY – REOPENING PLAN & REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration: July 21 – July 24, 2020 9:00 am -2:00 pm

Registration packets will be located on our website so parents who want to download the application can fill it out prior to coming to the school. Those who do not want to download the packet may come to the school starting July 21-July 24, 2020, from 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. Parents who completed registration starting April 22 - June 6, 2020 do not have to re-register.

East Side Elementary Daily Procedures for 2020-2021

Students:

1. Students who ride the bus or walk will enter the building through the front door/bus lane.
2. Car riders will enter through the west side door of the cafeteria. Car riders' temperatures will be checked while they are sitting in the vehicle. If the student has a fever, he/she will not be allowed to get out the car.
3. All students will have their temperature checked prior to entering the building.

Isolation Room

1. Isolation room will be Room 2.
2. All bus riders and students with a temperature will be held there until parents can pick them up.

Daily Movement

1. Movement will take place as normal with a few minor adjustments to help reduce congestion. Students will be required to wear masks during hallway transitions (specials, restroom, office, etc.).
2. Student traffic will follow one direction which is the same procedure used in the morning as students enter the building for breakfast.

Mask/Face Covering

1. All students will be required to have a face mask.
2. There will be areas and times where students will be required to wear masks and areas where they may be removed. Teachers will require students to wear masks during certain activities.

Classroom Procedures

1. All teachers will complete a seating chart.
2. Teachers will ensure student tables/desks are facing the same direction.
3. Teachers & students will be asked to wear masks and/or face shields when social distancing is not feasible.
4. Teachers will establish procedures for cleaning and disinfecting students' tables and desks.

Distance Teaching and Learning Plan

Effective distance teaching and learning will require a team effort from all parties involved.

Student/Parents Expectations

- Attend distance learning training session(s).

- Assignments will be graded for accuracy.
- Let teacher know when students do not understand.
- Parents will monitor their grades via Canvas on a weekly basis.
- Communicate with teacher via telephone, email, message on Canvas, and Zoom.
- Check email daily.
- Participate and complete all activities, assignments, and assessments.
- Download Canvas Parent and Student app to receive announcements and reminders of assignments and for tracking progress of students' work.
- Provide reliable internet service for student.
- Parents will have an opportunity to change their child's learning option the week of August 31-September 4, 2020. At that point you will not be able to change your option until the end of the first semester, the week of December 18, 2020.
- Maintain integrity with students' assignments.
- Encourage students to attend all Zoom meetings, complete and submit all assignments on time.
- Provide a device other than a cell phone to begin distance learning. The district is in the process of purchasing a device for every student, but we cannot guarantee when they will arrive.
