GUIDELINES FOR LATE ARRIVAL/EARLY DISMISSAL

Rocky Hill High School continues to be a closed campus for students, meaning students cannot leave campus during the school day. However, in an attempt to prioritize the health, safety and well being of all our students and staff, parents have the option to allow their student(s) to remain home for the first and/or the last period of the day if a student has no scheduled class (Periods 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9).

Students who have late arrival/early dismissal must adhere to the following guidelines.

1. Students who do not have an assigned class at the beginning and/or at the end of the day should not be on campus during those times.
2. A student who has a special reason to stay in school during the last period on a particular day (e.g., meeting with a faculty member) must report to the teacher's location and leave immediately after their business has concluded.
3. Students are responsible for their own transportation.
4. SPECIAL NOTES:
 - a) Students must apply for late arrival/early dismissal option each semester.
 - b) Schedules will not be changed to allow students to participate in the late arrival/early dismissal option.
 - c) Request for late arrival/early dismissal must be in writing (special form) and must include the signature of the student and parent/guardian.
