

# What should students do BEFORE September 1<sup>st</sup>?

## Find a quiet spot

Look around the house for a quiet spot to attend school remotely, preferably a table or desk. Have paper and pen ready to take notes.

## Login to your device and connect to Wi-Fi:

Login using the email address (first part of your email address) and password provided by the district.

The default **username** will be the first, middle, and last initials of the student followed by the last 6 digits of the student's state ID. If the user has multiple middle names, it will use the first one only. If the student does not have a middle name it will only use the first and last initials.


The default **Password** will be the student's first letter of first name (capital), first letter of last name (lower), and the full birthday in mmddyyyy format.


Example of user with Middle name(s):

John Jacob Martin Smith, born March 5th, 2013. State ID of 0123456789

Password: Js03052013

Log into Schoology  and Google (in a new tab) with email address and password. Know your individual schedule and the daily bell schedule.

Charge your device or be near a power source.

\*After September 1<sup>st</sup> ...Login to Schoology daily before 11:59PM when school starts to be counted present, but the expectation is for students to follow and attend classes based on the remote schedule provided. We are in remote learning which means students are not physically present, but information is relayed through technology in real time at the teachers' pace. This differs from virtual learning which is student-paced.
