## Central High School Parking Regulations 2019-2020 School Year

- ❖ Cars will be ticketed and/or towed at owners' expense for violation of parking regulations. Parking is a privilege that may be revoked without a refund for parking violations. Vehicles parked within 1000 feet of school property are subject to search.
- 1. Vehicles on the campus of Central High School must have a 2019-2020 Central High School hang tag hanging from the rear view mirror & must be in a marked parking space.
- 2. Once a student drives on campus, he/she is considered 'at school' and must check out legally in the front office to leave campus again.
- Students may not loiter (hang-out) in the parking lot before or after school. Students must exit their vehicles & report directly to the school building <u>immediately</u> upon arrival to school.
- 4. For afternoon dismissal all student drivers must turn right out of the parking lot.
- 5. Dream Team spaces are marked with a DT in front of the number. All other parking is assigned by your parking permit number.
- 6. Any student vehicle parked anywhere on campus other than the student parking lot will likely be TOWED and parking privilege REVOKED!!!
- Radios and sound systems must be kept at a volume that cannot be heard outside of the vehicle within 1000 feet of the Central High School campus.
- 7. Students will not be allowed to go to the student parking lot during the school day to get items left in the car.
- 8. Students may not be on your cell phone while driving in student parking lot.
- 9. Students will be allowed to drive to TEC for 3<sup>rd</sup>/4th periods only and only if the student is in the DCT program and drives to his/her work immediately after TEC classes. These students must obtain permission from an Assistant Principal at CHS and the principal at TEC. All other TEC students must ride the bus to and from TEC. Students may not transport other students to the TEC for any reason.
- 10. Students/parents will not be allowed to park or drop off in the mornings or pick up in the afternoons in the 400 parking lot.
- 11. Permits <u>may not</u> be transferred to other students. Any student who allows someone else to use their hang tag will loose their parking privilege for the remainder of the school year. Parking hang tags can not be shared! (One person per \$40 hangtag purchase.)
- 12. Student drivers must complete a Drug Consent Testing form to be allowed to park on campus.

\*\*\* NEW STATE LAW requires that CHS report to the DMV any student who accumulates 10 or more unexcused absences in the current school year or in the previous academic year. Driving privileges of those students will be revoked by the DMV (and by CHS).

Carroll County Schools On-Campus Student Parking Rules

Students must operate their vehicles in a safe and proper manner at all times on ANY Carroll County School campus. Student drivers must obey school rules and the Discipline Code.

The following are parking privilege information, rules, regulations and procedures:

## DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- 1. First in-school and/or out-of-school suspension = 1 week parking suspension.
- 2. Second ISS and/or OSS = parking privilege revoked for remainder of the year.
- Substance abuse on campus = parking privilege revoked for one year in addition to Discipline Code Policy.
- 4. Weapon found on student or in vehicle = parking privilege revoked for at least one year and possible permanent revocation in addition to Discipline Code Policy.
- 5. On campus driving misconduct (scratching off, speeding wheelies, etc) can result in revocation of parking for up to one year.
- Leaving campus without permission will result in parking privilege revoked for a year.
- 7. Transporting another student off campus without authorization will result in revocation of parking privilege for one year.
- 8. Failure to register a vehicle with the school or improperly parking a vehicle (such as parking in an unassigned space) can result in not only revocation of parking privileges, but also having your car towed away at your expense.

## Parking Consequences for Unexcused Tardies to School

1st tardy – Warning – student issued a copy of the warning

- 2<sup>nd</sup> tardy Probation student issued warning that future tardies will result in loss of parking
- $3^{rd}$  tardy Loss of parking privilege for 5 school days. Student must surrender parking permit to the front office upon check in.
- 4<sup>th</sup> tardy Loss of parking privilege for 20 school days. Student must surrender parking permit to the front office upon check in.
- 5<sup>th</sup> tardy Loss of parking privilege for remainder of the semester. Student must surrender parking permit to the front office upon check in.

\*\*\*Any student who parks on campus after a  $5^{th}$  unexcused tardy to school will have his/her car towed at his/her expense without warning.\*\*\*
