

How To Sign In For Adobe Products

As of September 2020, the Adobe licensing model that Warsaw R-IX utilizes has changed to their Named License model. With that change also comes a change in the sign in process. When you first try to open an Adobe application (say Photoshop), you will be prompted for credentials. You will enter your email address and then click the blue “Continue” button.

Next, you will enter your **Windows** password. This is the big change from previous years. In the past, it was the Google password, but that will not work any longer. You must use your **Windows** password (i.e., the password to first log on to the computer). Then click the blue “Sign in” button.



To keep from having to re-enter your password when opening other applications (like going from Photoshop to Dreamweaver), be sure to check on the option beside “Don’t show this again.” Then click the blue “Yes” button.



The Adobe application will now open.
