### Summer Meals Offered for Children

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School Nutrition Program (SNP) will continue to offer meals free of charge this summer to children ages 18 and under. Meals will be offered through either pickup at one of six schools or mobile routes for specific neighborhoods. Community organizations may also register for summer meals. Children do not need to be enrolled in the Houston County School District to receive meals.

For pick up, meal packs will be offered on Wednesdays, from June 2 - July 28, 2021. Parents may drive through one of six schools each Wednesday, between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m., to pick up meal packs in the car rider or bus lane. Children do not need to be present. Meal packs will be offered at these six schools:

- Feagin Mill Middle – 1200 Feagin Mill Road, Warner Robins;
- Huntington Middle – 206 Wellborn Road, Warner Robins;
- Matt Arthur Elementary – 2500 Hwy 127, Kathleen;
- Northside High – 926 Green Street, Warner Robins;
- Perry High – 1307 North Avenue, Perry; and
- Thomson Middle – 301 Thomson Street, Centerville.

Meals will be distributed by vans traveling routes through Houston County neighborhoods. Routes will be similar to past years. Van routes will be posted to the SNP webpage by the end of May. \*

Meals will also be available for community youth programs, such as athletic practices, Bible schools, clubs, etc. operating between June 1 and July 29. Any group wishing to participate in the SNP summer feeding program must register with School Nutrition three weeks prior to the start of their program. All sites are able to serve any child 18 years of age or younger.
