The Randolph County Board of Education met for a work session on Monday, March 18, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. in the Central Services Boardroom, located at the 2222-C South Fayetteville Street Office in Asheboro. Finance & Budget Division

1. Superintendent's 2019-2020 Proposed Budget

Todd Lowe, Finance Officer, presented the Superintendent's 2019-2020 Proposed Budget for the Board's review and any questions.

Curriculum & Instruction Division

1. Showcase of 2019-2020 Program of Studies/Curriculum

Catherine Berry, Assistant Superintendent, presented the 2019-2020 Program of Studies. She shared this is an annual resource developed by a committee of school level and district level staff. It requires a full year of review and interpretation. An even greater emphasis has been placed on parent outreach and the use of our social media to increase the level of parental, staff, and student awareness in regards to the information in our Program of Studies.

2. Cooperative Innovative High School Agreement for the Randolph Early College High School
Ms. Berry shared that the renewal for the Cooperation Innovative High School Agreement for the Randolph Early College High School is every five years. The completed Cooperative Innovative High School Renewal Form for the Randolph Early College High School was submitted to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction on March 11, 2019. This renewal is good for five school years through March 2024.

Operations Division

1. Process for naming new middle school

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent, presented to the board the process for naming the new middle school based on Board Policy 9300 (Naming Facilities). After the Board's review and discussion, the consensus was to stay with our current policy in order to move forward with the process of naming a new middle school. Revisions to the policy will begin at a later date. Mr. Trotter also shared the timeline for the new middle school.
