SUBJECT: Application Procedure

Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 may apply for Community Service, a program in which credit is given based on service in an activity of a voluntary nature. Students should refer to the description in the <u>Program of Studies</u> for further information.

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. Registration includes filing a properly completed application within the <u>first ten</u> <u>days of each semester</u> signed by the student, parent/guardian, and community service supervisor.
- 2. Permission is granted on a semester basis. Students must reapply each new semester.
- 3. Credit is given based on the nature of the activity, time involvement, and the completion of a journal of activities signed by the supervisor. The determination of the type of activity that is eligible for credit is made by the school principal.
- 4. Forms for the journal may be obtained after the application is turned in to the office.
- 5. To earn one-quarter (.25) credit, a minimum of fifty (50) voluntary hours in service must be completed. A minimum of one hundred (100) hours will earn one-half (.50) credit.
- 6. Journals must be properly signed and turned in at the end of the semester by the first day of exams, or credit will not be awarded.
- 7. Students may be dropped from the program at any time if the intent of the program is not being served, if school performance is affected, or if regular school rules and regulations are violated.
- 8. Grades are given at the end of the semester by the principal, not be the supervisor.
- 9. Students must be taking a regular program of six full-time subjects <u>plus</u> physical education or health to be eligible.
- 10. The Community Service credit may not be used as the final credit for graduation (that is, the 22<sup>nd</sup> credit). These credits are considered in addition to any credit earned toward graduation.
