Attendance: The Randolph County School Board Policy states that each student is allowed 5 absences per semester. After 5 absences, your child may not receive credit for the course. Good attendance is mandatory for success in this class. It will be essential for students to login to Canvas and check email daily in order to be successful this semester. **To be counted present, your child must be in class or log into Canvas daily to submit their attendance via a google attendance form.** *If a student misses 3 or more days in AP Calculus, the student will be required to take a teacher made exam which will be 25% of their final grade.*

Cell Phones: Cell phones are a big distraction in a classroom. Your child will be given a warning on the first class day about cell phone usage in class. On the next offense, I confiscate the phone and turn it into the office.

Exam: The AP exam is required to take if your child would like to earn college credit for taking this course. However, your child is highly encouraged to take the AP exam. A score of a three, four or five will result in college credit. If your child chooses not to take the exam, they will not be eligible to receive college credit.

Late Work: Any work turned in late will be counted as 55% of the grade that was earned.
