using there digressions on how to handle the situation. Maintenance calls are regarding sewer

back up, people are flushing gloves, shop towels, etc. Items that are not to be flush, is what

maintenance are finding. Students are to walk their bikes across the crosswalk not ride them

across, safety issue.
