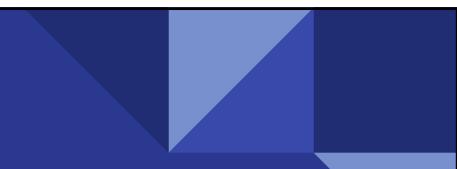

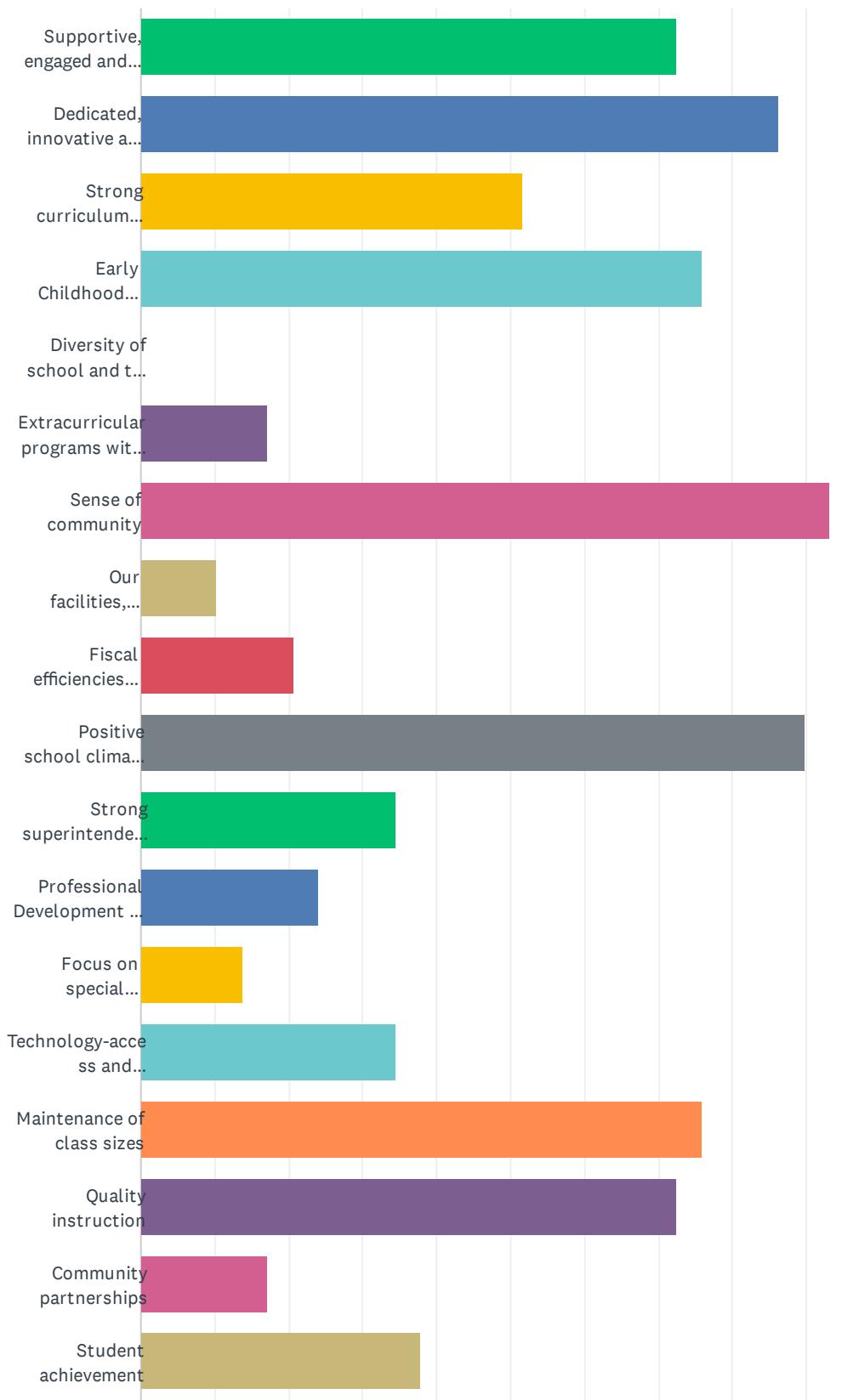

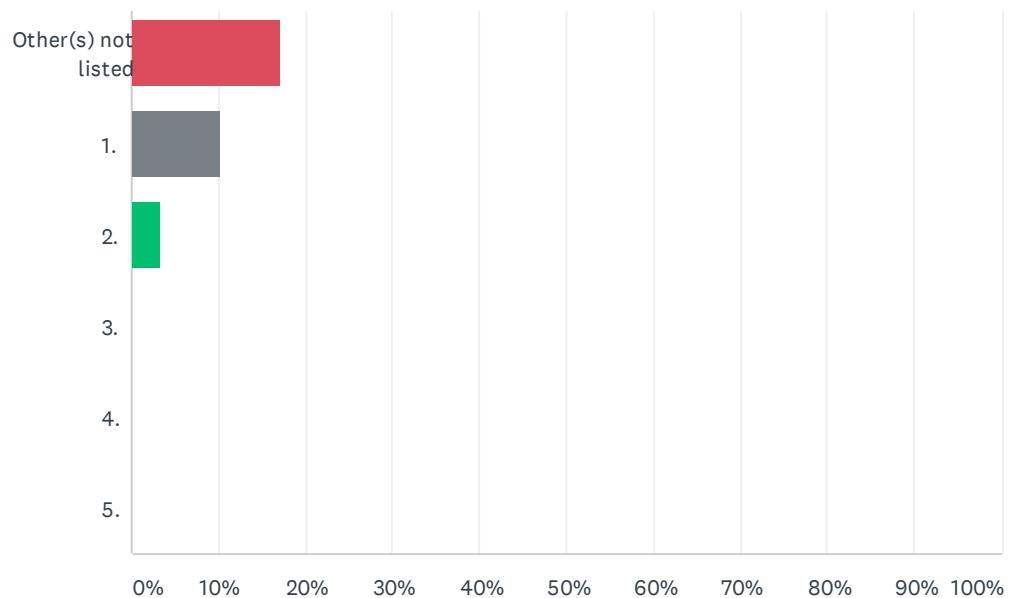


Q1 What do you believe are the top ten (10) strengths of the Califon School District?

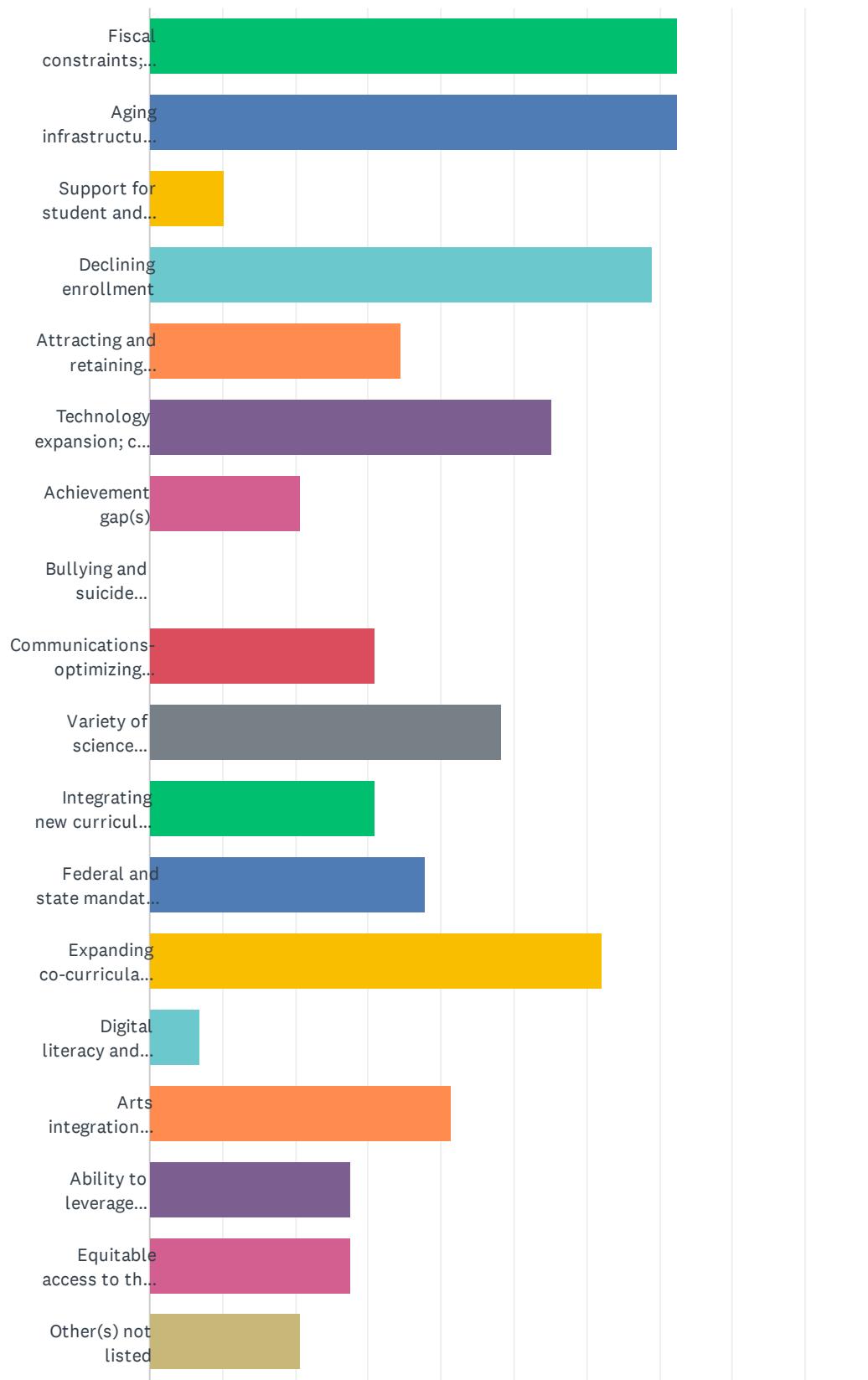

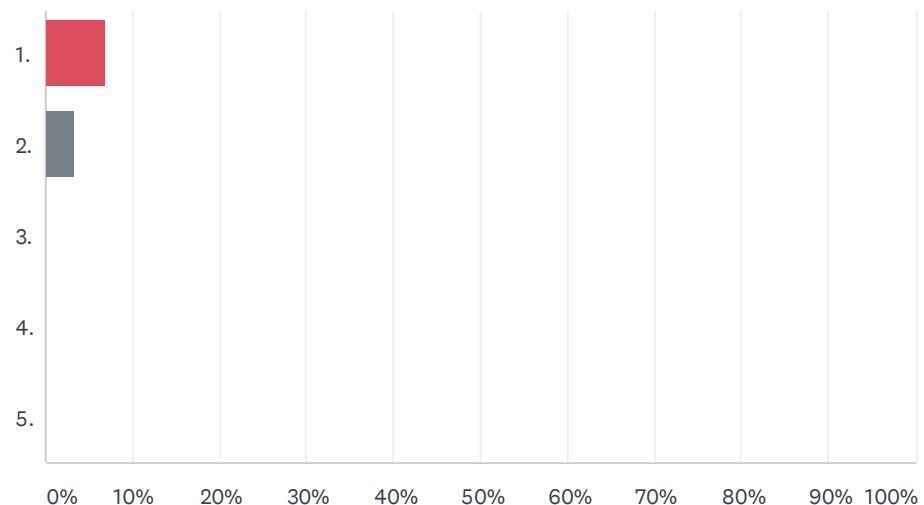
