Dear Families:

After much collaboration, hard work, and analysis, I am pleased to release the North Wildwood Return to Learning Plan for the 2020-2021 school year. The full plan is posted on our website.

This plan is based upon the conditions and limitations as of this moment in time. If a situation demands us to implement another version of the plan, the District remains prepared to address all circumstances and will communicate those modifications promptly.

To assist you in better understanding the plan, please review the below information.

1. All in-person learning for students will be five (5) days a week. We will follow a traditional schedule and calendar.
2. The first day of school for all students is Wednesday, September 9, 2020. Wednesday, September 9- Friday, September 11, will be early dismissal days for students.
3. All parents will be provided the option of a 100% remote learning experience.
4. Parents who are interested in online school should complete the Online Schooling Declaration Form on our website: [www.mmace.com](http://www.mmace.com) before August 21, 2020.
5. Screening: All students and staff will be screened daily before entering the building.
6. Class sizes will range from 8-12 students per class; enabling us to social distance and minimize the risk of infection.
7. Face coverings are mandatory for all staff and students with the following exceptions:
  - a. During designated supervised breaks, physical education, music class, lunch and recess.
  - b. In situations when wearing a face-covering places, an individual with a documented underlying health condition at an increased health risk.

c. PK/K students are expected to wear face coverings; however, we acknowledge the challenges that are associated with students of this age.

On behalf of the Board of Education, the administration, and all of our staff, I thank you for your continued support, understanding, and cooperation as we all prepare for another school year in this unique educational atmosphere.
