TEMPORARY FACILITIES

The chief school administrator and board secretary/business administrator shall make recommendations to the board concerning the most advantageous means of providing needed facilities. Rather than building, the board may rent necessary facilities on a short or long term basis when it is in the best interests of the district. Such facilities shall comply with state standards.

Any facilities found to be substandard according to the administrative code shall be corrected as quickly as possible in compliance with law.
