

Billingsley School Roadmap to Reopening

Prevention:


- Students are allowed to bring their own hand sanitizer and masks from home.
- Water fountains will be closed. Water bottles may be brought from home. The bottle must be able to close completely.
- Students will wear face masks when entering/exiting the building and duration of class time.

Transportation:


- No field trips until further notice.
- Students will report immediately to homeroom upon arrival to school.
- No student may enter the build prior to 7:15 a.m.
- Car riders will unload and load in the back of the school.

Entry & Exit of School Campus:

- Visitors are allowed in the main office only and must wear a mask.
- Visitors may not eat lunch with students.
- Students will wear face masks when entering & exiting the building and for the duration of class.
- Entrance and exit flow paths will be marked.

Breakfast & Lunch:

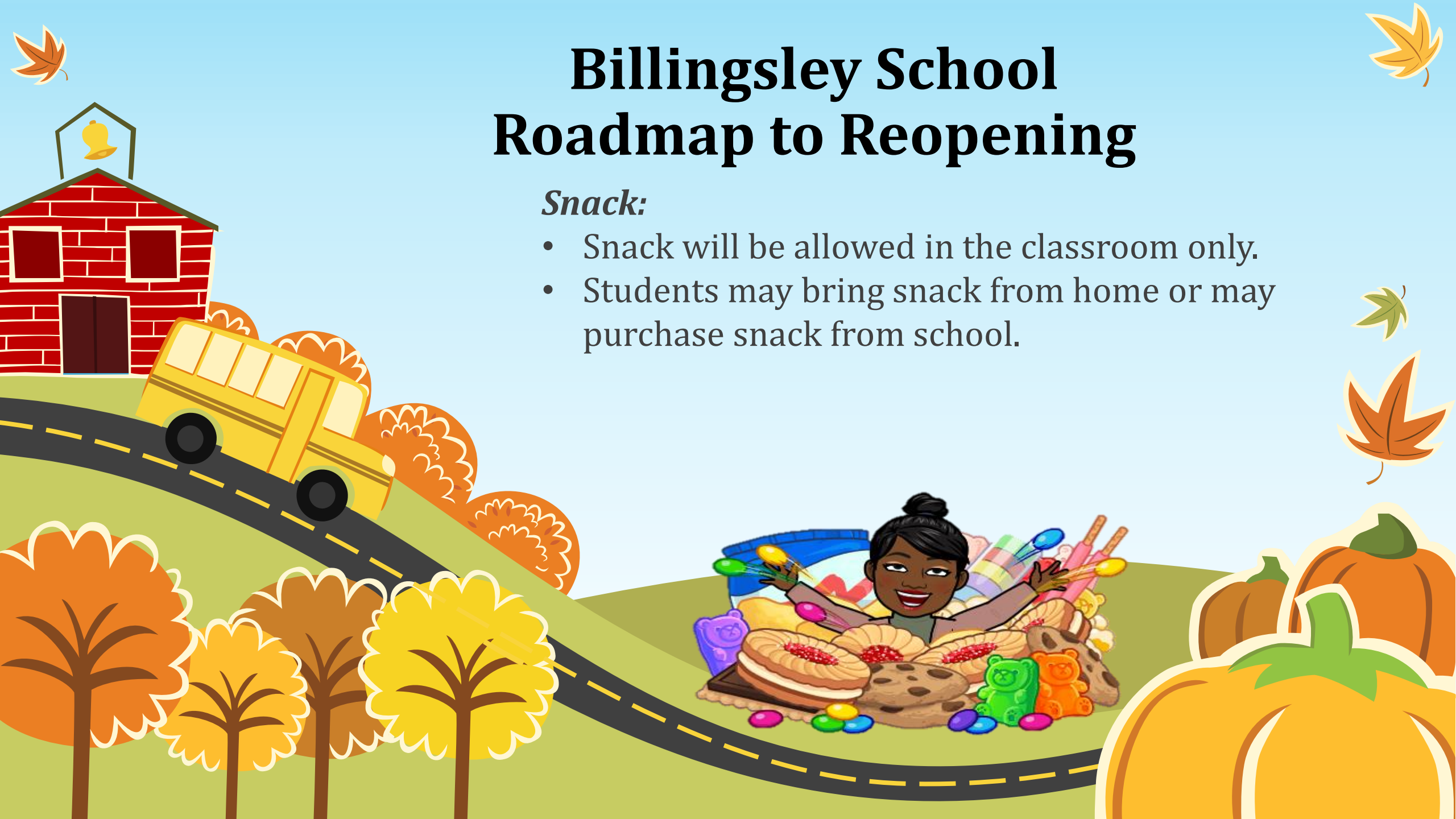
- Grades K-2 will eat all meals in the lunchroom.

- Students may bring snack from home or may purchase snack from school.






Billingsley School Roadmap to Reopening
