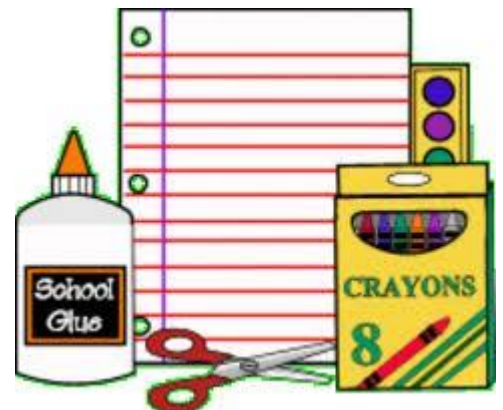
Each child should have:

Second Grade Supply List

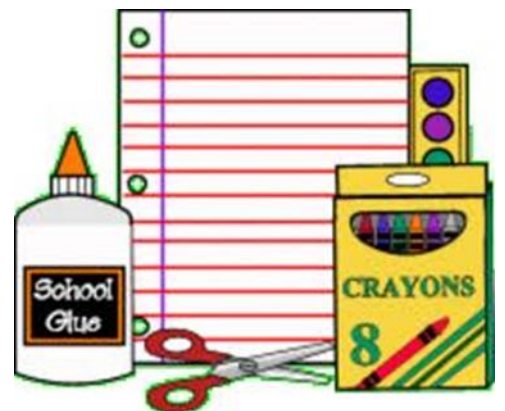
Each child should have:
