HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE HISET® EXAM

Students under 18 years of age are required to have an approved Request to Waive the Age Requirement form on file with the NH Department of Education, Bureau of Adult Education prior to scheduling an exam. This form meets the requirements of NH Ed 704 for admission to testing.

- 1. Obtain a copy of the Request to Waive the Age Requirement
- 2. Take the Official Practice Test.
- 3. Register on the HiSET eRegistration system at: https://hiset.ets.org
- 4. Get permission from your school
- 5. Get permission from your parent or guardian
- 6. Submit the Request to Waive the Age Requirement form to:
