Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Elementary (Grades K - 4): Tawas Area Schools is offering face to face and remote learning opportunities for our elementary students. Families have the ability to choose which delivery mode works best for their child.
Middle School (Grades 5 - 8): Tawas Area Schools is offering face to face and remote learning opportunities for our middle school students. Families have the ability to choose which delivery mode works best for their child.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Tawas Area Schools is offering face to face and remote learning opportunities for our high school students. Families have the ability to choose which delivery mode works best for their child.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other Special populations:
Tawas Area Schools is offering both face to face and remote learning for special needs students. Families have the ability to choose which delivery mode works best for their child's needs to meet their free and appropriate educational rights. This option has been offered based on the contingency plans and the needs of the student on a case by case basis.
