# 2021-2022 Registration

The Student Advisement program is designed to assist students in acquiring the knowledge and skills needed to make decisions that enable them to take full advantage of the curriculum offered at Northside High School.



## Foreign Language

- NHS offers two foreign languages: Spanish and French.
- Although foreign language is not required for graduation, students planning to attend a four-year college immediately after high school <u>MUST</u> take two units of the same foreign language.
- If a foreign language is not listed as a required course and you would like to take a foreign language, please place one line through an elective you would like to change and write the foreign language you would like to take beside it.

# Things to Consider Before Choosing Electives

- If you are starting a new CTAE pathway, you must select the first course in the pathway.
- If you choose a dual enrollment elective at HCCA, (will be in grey with a star by it) you must apply and be accepted to Central Georgia Tech and/or Middle Georgia State.
- If you are interested in dual enrollment through a local college (ex. GMC or CGTC, not HCCA), you MUST schedule an appointment with your counselor via email.

# More Things to Consider

• The courses listed below require prior-approval. These courses WILL NOT be added to your schedule until prior approval is received from the teacher and/or counselors.

#### Course Selection

- · Look at your registration sheet.
- You should have 12 classes on your sheet unless you are already a Dual Enrollment student or a HCCA student. HCCA courses take up two periods.
- Make sure that you have an A (first semester) and B (second semester) class in the following areas: English, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- If you are missing a class in any of these 4 areas, write the subject area you are missing (ex. "Missing math").

### Course Selection Cont.

- If you are currently taking a CTAE course, you have automatically been scheduled for the next course in the sequence.
- If a different elective is requested, please place <u>one</u> line through the course and <u>write</u> the name of the preferred course beside it.
- You will need to write in one more elective class to fill your 7<sup>th</sup> period slot.
- Then, write in four alternate electives in the event your preferred elective is not available.

# Summary

#### By the end of the day:

- 1. The student should have checked to make sure they have the A/B portion of the 4 core academic classes listed or indicated what is missing.
- 2. All of the student's core academic teachers should have initialed that the next course listed is correct or corrected it.
- 3. The student should have verified electives listed or chosen new electives.
- 4. The student should have listed a 7th course.
- 5. The students should have listed four alternate electives.

# Final Step

• Turn in your registration sheet to your 6<sup>th</sup> period teacher (or the last teacher you see at NHS) before leaving school.
