### MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Sumter County Board of Education was called to order by Vice Chairman Rick Barnes with the following other members present: Alice Green, Edith Green, Meda Krenson and Sylvia Roland.

A motion was made by Ms. Alice Green to adopt the agenda; second by Mrs. Roland; motion carried unanimously.

### FUND RAISERS

4. Sumter County Middle School to sell Krispy Kreme Doughnuts, cookie dough, t-shirts, candy, soft drinks, healthy snacks, locker rentals, school paraphernalia, etc., August 6, 2018 through May 23, 2019.
5. Americus Sumter Ninth Grade Academy to sell t-shirts, school pictures, candy, sodas, chips, doughnuts, and other food items, lanyards and to sponsor athletic events, August 6, 2018 – May 23, 2019.
6. Americus Sumter High School (HOSA) to sell t-shirts and to sponsor jean day for teachers monthly, t-shirt days for teachers and breast cancer walk, August 6, 2018 – May 18, 2019.

The policy committee recommended placing Policy JBC on the table for 30 days; motion carried unanimously.


**PROPERTY COMMITTEE**
