

BOARD POLICY
Child Abuse or Neglect

Descriptor Code: JGI

All employees of the Webster County Board of Education, including all teachers, administrators, guidance counselors and visiting teachers, as well as all school social workers and school psychologists employed by the Webster County Board of Education, who have reason or cause to believe that a child is being or has been abused shall report that abuse in accordance with Georgia law and the protocol for handling child abuse cases for Webster County, Georgia.
