Perry High School Council Minutes

February 25, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Martin at 7:02 a.m. in the media center conference room at Perry High School.

Mr. Martin led the group in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from the January 14, 2020 meeting were reviewed by the committee and approved with a motion by Dr. Herbert followed by a second from Ms. Prater.

Discussion regarding old business included:

- PBIS business – Disciple referrals are lower by approximately 480 as compared with the same time period from last year. Credit to the PBIS program and teachers for handling minor incidents at the classroom level
- Scholarship signings – There will be a second round of scholarship signings in April
- Dr. Herbert reminded the committee that evening advisement will be March 2-4.
