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O'Bannon High School Distant Learning

O'Bannon High School's goal during this time is the same as was before, to help foster high performing students. In order for us to continue our goal, we want to provide students with quality instruction that gives the students the opportunity to learn and master objectives, while also interacting with their teachers. Therefore, O'Bannon High School has decided to provide you with our comprehensive plan for our current closure.

#1. Virtual School Online

- O'Bannon High School has decided to enroll all students, 7-12 into the online education program called Edgenuity. Edgenuity is a leading provider of K-12 online learning solutions, partnering with schools and districts throughout the country to provide the tools and support they need to leverage technology to improve student outcomes. The program has been currently in usage by the school for the past two years (Spanish/French/STEM). Students will use their current log-in information and will self-enroll themselves in the classes that currently match their schedule (Please see directions for self-enrollment on the school's webpage). If a student is unaware of their Edgenuity log-in information, please call or email obhshelp@westernline.org with the student's name/grade level.

#2. Online Correspondence

- Many of our teachers have been communicating with students via other educational online platforms like Google Classroom, Readworks, Classdojo, School Status and general email. Students who have been completing assignments in this form, may continue without enrolling in the Edgenuity classes if not needed. However, the student can use the Edgenuity program to complete assignments for teachers who have yet to assign online correspondence or hardcopy packets.

#3. Hardcopy Packets

- Finally, we are aware that several of our students may lack the technology or resources to complete online schooling and online correspondence. Therefore, we ask that those students complete the take-home packets that will be located and distributed by the school. We currently have set packets for 7th/8th grades that focus on ELA and Math. Students 9th-12th will need to pick up/receive packets from the individual classroom teachers. Students and/or parents, if you come to the school and a packet is not ready, please leave your information or again email obhshelp@westernline.org so that packets can be made available in a timely manner.

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- Packet distribution will be provided during lunch distribution that will be held daily as schedule.
