The local health department has determined that the bulk of new COVID-19 cases are occurring due to small social gatherings, ex. birthday parties etc. Currently the Lewis County Health Department (LCHD) is doing most of the contact tracing for schools; however, this may fall on schools to do if cases increase rapidly. The LCHD has given new guidance on low-risk and high-risk symptoms and person-to-person contact, and has created and dispersed a new Student Symptom Decision Tree.
