



Welcome to Geometry in B11

***Please read through all the information provided, regardless if you are an in class learner or on virtual. All students need to be familiar with all the information. If you are not a virtual learner, you will still need to read the information that is not specifically labeled for virtual learner. If you are an in-class learner, you still need to read the information that is labeled virtual learner.**

Schoology and Pearson eTextbook:

ALL students must familiarize themselves with the online Schoology and eTextbook. All students will have a classroom within Schoology as well as the eTextbook. It is crucial you are able to log in and utilize those resources. I will be using both of those tools for instruction and assigning assignments. To log into you Schoology, you will go to <http://desotoms.schoology.com/home> and enter your email with the given password. To get to the textbook you will go to <https://www.desotocountyschools.org/onlinetextbooks> and follow the directions. Students will need to know their MSIS # (lunch number) and email. Email is as follows: first initial of first name, first initial of last name, last 6 digits of their lunch number @dcsms.org

What you will need: ½ or 1” binder, Composition Notebook, Binder Dividers

You will need to have a binder for this class. This is too help you stay organized and keep things in place as we learn throughout this semester. The composition notebook will be used to take notes over material we have used.

Material:

Every student in my class will have **their own** plastic zip-bag on their desk that they will not be sharing with any other student. Within this bag is two pencils, a dry erase marker and eraser, a glue stick, scissors, and a calculator. **THESE BAGS DO NOT LEAVE MY CLASSROOM.** You are responsible for all the material within your assigned bag. You are not allowed to get up and walk around in class, so if you need something else, you must raise your hand.

Day Starts:

Once you enter my room, you are to be seated in your seat. You are **not** allowed to walk around the room and wait for the bell to ring to get seated. You are required to be seated at your assigned seat once you enter my room.

Bell Work:

There will always be math problems located on the front board of the classroom as soon as you enter the room. You are to take out you're your bell work page and complete the math problems at your desk (showing work) once you enter the room. Bell work is **not** "all class period" problems. You will be given 10 minutes tops to complete them. Bell work will need to be answered in your notebook on a bell work page for the week.

Virtual learners: You will also have a bell work located in the bell work folder on Schoology. You should always start the day by completing the bell work first. Read the directions given on the assignment, complete, and submit it. You will either submit on Schoology or through your interactive textbook online. Directions will be given with every assigned bell work.

Homework:

You will have homework and/or independent work every day in this class. You must complete all assignments. This is to help you practice the skills that you have learned that day. Make sure you stay organized so you do not lose your homework. This can be helpful when preparing for a test.

Virtual learners: You will also have homework/independent assignments in the assignments folder located in Schoology. You must complete the assignments every day by the deadline date given to receive credit for them. You will either submit on Schoology or through your interactive textbook online. Directions will be given with every assigned within the independent practice folder.

ACT:

We will be looking at many ACT questions this semester to help prepare you for when you have to take the ACT in the future. The ACT is an important part of your education, therefore, the only way to get better is by practicing. Many of these problems will align with geometry that we are covering in class to help better prepare you for the real ACT. We will also look at other math subject areas that appear on the test every so often as well.

Virtual learners: Same as stated above.

Quizzes:

We will be taking a short quiz almost every day. These quizzes will be based on what we have just learned in class. This is to check immediate understanding to see where we are at that day for that lesson. Again, this just to check understanding, but a required assignment.

Virtual learners: You will also have the quizzes. I will assign them within Schoology and through your textbooks. Directions for how to submit will be stated every time within the assignment.

Individual Tests:

You will have one at the end of each chapter. They are always announced in advance. I will tell you verbally and it will be written on the board, often a week or more in advance. If you are absent the day of the test, the next test will count for both, because tests are cumulative. **Most of these will be taken through the etextbook and/or schoology. It is crucial you know how to use both of those platforms.**

Virtual learners: Same as stated above.

Bathroom:

You must use the bathroom during class changes. Once you are in the classroom you are to remain at your seat. You will not be allowed to get up and walk around. If it is an **emergency** then you will need to raise your hand quietly. I will then have to fill out a hall pass for you to use. Again, this is for absolute emergencies only.

Make-up Work:

If you miss X amount of days, you will have X amount of days to make it up. There will be folders on the wall that are labeled Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. On the days you're absent, it is **your responsibility** to collect your work from the proper folders (work will be stapled together with your name on it for each day). If you fail to turn it in by the X amount of days, you will be given a zero.

- Check with your teammates and the "While You Were Out Wall" before you ask me make-up work.

- Tests will **NOT** be in the make-up folders. You will need to get with me to make up a test. This should not be in the middle of class or while I am giving instruction. You can email me, see me during 4th block, on break, or another appropriate time.
- If you know you will not be out ahead of time, let me know so I can get the assignment to you.

Cell Phones/Headphones:

You are allowed to bring a device to the classroom to complete assignments through Schoology if you choose to. However, you are only allowed to use your device if given permission. There may be times we will use our phones to submit assignments and/or complete lessons, but it is strictly to only be used for what we are completing in class. If I see you on your device when you should not be, or doing something you are not allowed to do in class, I will confiscate it and you will have to pick it up from the front office at the end of the day.

Additional Information and Rules to Follow:

- You **MUST** go directly to your desk when you enter the room each day.
- If you need to get up or get something, you must raise you hand and ask for permission before you get up and move.
- Students must walk on the right side of the hallways.
- Teachers and Students are **required** to wear a mask in the classroom and throughout the school to help eliminate the spread of germs.
- Students, both in class and virtual must become familiar with Schoology and the Online Textbook.
- You must not share ANYTHING with another student.
