- Drowning is the number 1 cause of death for kids 5 years old and younger
- Each year over 300 kids under age 14 die by accidental drowning
- 5,200 kids require treatment in emergency rooms with swimming related injuries
- ***Drowning is silent and happens quickly!***

The Hardee County Community Recreation Center offers an opportunity for your child to learn personal safety and water survival skills in a closely supervised environment just in time for summer vacation. Our program is totally committed to teaching swimming skills to individuals from the age of 24 months and up. We ensure the finest in aquatic programming by maintaining a trained and qualified staff.

An infant drown-proofing class age 6 months to 24 months is also available (Parent will get in the pool with infant).

- Cost for each registration is **\$50.00**
- Cost for students 5 and under and/or with family hardships is **\$40**
