2020/21 Non-Resident Tuition

The Vidalia City Board of Education has set Non-Resident Tuition for the **2020/21 school year at \$200 per child**. This fee applies to students who reside outside the city limits of Vidalia, Georgiarefer to VBOE Policy JBCB.

Tax credits are allowed for non-resident students whose parents pay school taxes to the City of Vidalia, Georgia. Tuition may be partially or fully paid by presenting a City of Vidalia Ad Valorem Tax Receipt from the proceeding year. (The school tax portion of the bill will be deducted from tuition.)

- ❖ No prorated tuition refunds will be given for those students who move out of the city during the school term.

Tuition should be paid to the school where the child will attend. Each school will begin receiving tuition payments the **first day of pre-planning** during regular business hours and must be paid in full (or arrangements made with the building principal) on or before **the last day of pre-planning**. Tuition is non-refundable. No progress reports or report cards or other school documents will be issued to a non-resident student until tuition payments are current.
